

GoGreen Home Participating Contractor Application

Eligible Contractor Certifications

Pursuant to Title 4, Division 13, Article 5 of the California Code of Regulations (the Program Regulations) Section 10091.6, the Eligible Contractor,

- a. Agrees to follow the Program regulations, including the project requirements set forth in Section 10091.10.
- b. Agrees to hold and maintain a commercial general liability insurance policy or policies of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence throughout their participation in the Program.
- c. Agrees to permit an audit, by CAEATFA, of any of its records relating to the projects financed by Enrolled Loans during normal business hours on its premises or remotely, and to supply any other information relating to those projects as shall be requested by CAEATFA.
- d. Acknowledges that CAEATFA and the State of California will have no liability to it under the Program.
- e. Agrees to indemnify and hold CAEATFA harmless from any and all damages resulting from its representations, savings estimates, sales, warranties, maintenance, any installed measure, product, and/or system, and service for all installed measures, products, and/or systems.
- f. Certifies that it has no outstanding judgments or liens.
- g. Agrees to, and acknowledges that, it is solely responsible for identifying and making any and all disclosures to its customers as required under applicable laws.
- h. Agrees to, and acknowledges that, it shall comply with all applicable laws, possess and maintain all required state licenses, and remain in good standing with all governmental authorities having jurisdiction over its business.
- i. Acknowledges that the Investor-Owned Utilities (IOUs) (PG&E, SoCalGas, SCE, SDG&E) are not responsible for, and shall have no liability for:
 - The energy efficiency improvements funded through the Enrolled Loans supported through the Loss Reserve Accounts.
 - The assessment of potential benefits and costs associated with those improvements.
 - The selection of Participating Contractors.
 - The Eligible Contractor's marketing policies and practices.
 - CAEATFA's educational and outreach activities.
- j. Agrees that its representatives and agents are not hired by CAEATFA or any of the participating IOUs, and shall not represent themselves as being, or claim association or affiliation with CAEATFA or any of the participating IOUs in any capacity. Further, the applicant shall neither make false or misleading claims about any part of the Program or its performance, including energy performance savings, nor engage in fraudulent or deceitful conduct in the sale or installation of measures.
- k. Acknowledges that its employees and representatives shall be solely responsible for all representations made to Borrowers regarding the Program or work performed for a Borrower under the Program, and shall be responsible for all sales, installations, warranties, maintenance and service for all products and systems installed.
